



## RBC CANADIAN OPEN THE RINK TEE MARKER DESIGN CONTEST RULES

1. The Rink Tee Marker Design Contest (the “Contest”), sponsored by the Royal Canadian Golf Association operating as and hereby, “Golf Canada”, commences 12:00 am on April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026 ET and concludes at 11:59 pm ET on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026 (the “Contest Period”).

2. How to Enter:

3. The Contest is open to all residents of Canada, except for employees of Golf Canada, employees of the Provincial Golf Associations, affiliates advertising or promotional agencies, or members of those persons’ respective immediate families, or anyone with whom any of those persons are domiciled. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.

4. While this contest does not include any travel-related prizes, please note that, in accordance with Quebec regulations, we are unable to offer any travel-related prizes or reimburse travel expenses for Quebec residents. This includes any form of travel outside of Quebec, and we confirm that no such travel prize will be awarded as part of this contest.

5. There is a maximum of one entry per person. All duplicate entries will be disqualified and removed from the contest draw.

6. There are three prizes available for one winner valued at approximately CAD \$290, \$290 and \$500.

7. The prize is subject to restrictions, expiry dates, requirements and regulations noted on the prize certificates and applicable at the time of delivery and use. The prize is not transferable and will be awarded to the confirmed winner only. The prize is not convertible to cash and must be accepted as awarded. Prizes must be accepted as awarded, without substitutions or transfers.

8. A random draw for the prizes will be made by a Golf Canada representative from all eligible entries received during the contest period. The odds of winning a prize depend on the total number of eligible entries received for the Contest during the Contest Period.

9. Golf Canada will attempt to contact the selected entrants via email and/or telephone for approximately one (1) week following the draw, between 9:00 am ET and 7:00 pm ET. If Golf Canada is unable to contact the selected entrant after three (3) attempts, the submission will be rendered null and void and another selected entrant will be chosen. This procedure will be repeated until a selected entrant has been contacted within the given time. In order to win the prize, the selected entrant must have complied with the official contest rules, correctly answered the arithmetical skill-testing question to be administered by email, and sign and return Golf Canada’s standard declaration and release form which will be sent by email. The prize will be forfeited if the declaration and release form is not returned to Golf Canada within 15 days after prize notification.
